A highly detailed psychological drama with three strangers locked inside one hotel room. Wit, who returns to Thailand from a decade long stay in the US, along with his wife Dang, meets a 19 year old girl whom he invites in to their hotel room to rest up. It starts with subtle suspicions and builds up to hilarious jealousy, as the appearance of the young woman triggers the couple to suddenly realize how they had grown apart in their seven-year marriage, before reaching a devastating climax. In the final act, the couple is faced with the choice of going separate ways or turns around and embraces each other for a new beginning.
